Just as one man's poison is another man's food, Apostle Paul mistakes may be an achievement to you.

1. He was undefined: during his life, you can't know who Apostle Paul is from his association, he was different things to different people. He was a people pleaser, He didn't have a brand though he had a goal to share the gospel with everyone. Why his regarded as a mistake is because he was only able to win ' *some' not* ' *all* '.

"To the Jews I became like a Jew, to win the Jews. To those under the law, I became like one under the law (though I myself am not having the law) so as to win those under the law. To those not having the law I became like one not having the law(though I am not free from God's law but am under Christ law), so as to win those not having the law. To the the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all possible things to all people so that by all possible means I might save *some* . I do all this for the sake of gospel, that I may share in its blessings".

1 Corinthians 9: 19-23.

Not all protégé can follow this method, a young convert or someone still taking spiritual milk can get drawn away by those he wants to win, if he's a people pleaser.

Setting boundaries is very essential to follow this style. Know how far is to far. And you must be firm in your convictions to avoid being an example of 'evil communication corrupt good manners'.

It's not everyone we can influence and change though we are a light set on the hill.

How much life light do you have in you?, How much of God had been built in you?. It's not our eloquence that'll change someone, let's speak, interact, preach, relate according to the leading of the spirit.

Lord, please help us see you and what you'll want us become in your word. Amen!!

MORAL 1. NO ONE IS UNREACHABLE BY GOD.

Paul, at the time Saul, encountered God when he was on his way to cause God pain.

Now Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord [and relentless in his search for believers], went to the high priest, and he asked for letters [of authority] from him to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any men or women there belonging to the Way [believers, followers of Jesus the Messiah], men and women alike, he could arrest them and bring them bound [with chains] to Jerusalem. As he traveled he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him [displaying the glory and majesty of Christ];

ACTS 9: 1-3 AMP

There is no one that can't be reached.

Sometimes we belittle *the power of the gospel* and we think that certain people cannot be reached by God, *you play your part of reaching them and let God do his part.*

But how will people call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how will they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher (messenger)?

ROMANS 10:14 AMP

LESSON 2. Contentment

Considering Paul's wealth of knowledge and 'position' as a Jew, he was leaving the life.

though I myself might have [some grounds for] confidence in the flesh [if I were pursuing salvation by works]. If anyone else thinks that he has reason to be confident in the flesh [that is, in his own efforts to achieve salvation], I have far more: circumcised when I was eight days old, of the nation of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews [an exemplary Hebrew]; as to the [observance of the] Law, a Pharisee; as to my zeal [for Jewish tradition], a persecutor of the church; and as to righteousness [supposed right living] which [my fellow Jews believe] is in the Law, I proved myself blameless.

PHILIPPIANS 3:4 ¶ 6 AMP

But after coming into Christ and he couldn't brag with all these things, he still was content.

I know how to get along and live humbly [in difficult times], and I also know how to enjoy abundance and live in prosperity. In any and every circumstance I have learned the secret [of facing life], whether well-fed or going hungry, whether having an abundance or being in need. I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens and empowers me [to fulfill His purpose--I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

PHILIPPIANS 4:12 ¶ 13 AMP

No matter our financial, academic or social status, *we should grow in the life of contentment*.

Being able to make the best of what we have per time.

LESSON 3. God was priority for Him

LESSON 5. PREACH THE GOSPEL NOT WORDS OF MEN

"And when I came to you, brothers and sisters, proclaiming to you the testimony of God [concerning salvation through Christ], *I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom [no lofty words of eloquence or of philosophy as a Greek orator might do];* for I made the decision to know nothing [that is, to forego philosophical or theological discussions regarding inconsequential things and opinions while] among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified [and the meaning of His redemptive, substitutionary death and His resurrection]. *And my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words* of wisdom [using clever rhetoric], but [they were delivered] in demonstration of the [Holy] Spirit [operating through me] and of [His] power [stirring the minds of the listeners and persuading them], *so that your faith would not rest on the wisdom and rhetoric of men, but on the power of God.*"

1 CORINTHIANS 2:1 ¶ 2 ¶ 4 ¶ 5 AMP

It is the gospel that saves.

It is believing (and confessing) in the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus that saves not how well you can spin words or make up examples.

So, whether you are as eloquent as Obama or you aren't, share the gospel and God will handle the rest.
