1. WISDOM.

Wisdom is indeed profitable to direct. He was a real life explanation of "there is time for everything".

There was a time he told Esther not to reveal her identity, then a time came for the revealing of that identity.

Knowing 'when' to take a step, and when to refrain is important for every (wo)man

If any of you lacks wisdom [to guide him through a decision or circumstance], he is to ask of [our benevolent] God, who gives to everyone generously and without rebuke or blame, and it will be given to him.

JAMES 1:5 AMP

2. He loved people

For Mordecai the Jew was second only to King Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews and in favor with his many fellow people, for he worked for the good of his people and spoke for the welfare and peace of his whole nation.

ESTHER 10:3 AMP

...for he worked for the good of his people and spoke for the welfare and peace of his whole nation.

ESTHER 10:3 AMP

If you live for yourself alone, you can do much. Its pertinent that in the things we do and how we live, we must have a bigger picture in our minds. *We must work for the good of others.*
