Salvation begins at Calvary, however it did not end there.

The body (flesh) which houses man's spirit & soul is always desirous of doing things that are at variance with God's will.

It cannot please God because it had long been contaminated by Adamic nature

Exact work of Salvation

As we all know that man is made up of 3 nature (BODY, SPIRIT & SOUL). Now, which of this is exactly what Christ died for, is it the body, spirit or soul?

Christ died that our souls may be saved from eternal damnation

The complete work of salvation on the cross of Calvary goes beyond redeeming our mortal body.

All mortal body has received the judgment of death through Adam that is why we will be transformed into a glorified body or the incorruptible body on the day of resurrection.

Six days after this, Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John and led them up on a high mountain apart by themselves. And He was transfigured before them and became resplendent with divine brightness.

Now at death, the spirit returns to the giver. Therefore, the complete work of salvation was for the soul of men which is the exact nature of man that will be doomed for eternal death but redeemed by work of Christ at Calvary.

2. ***Instrument of salvation***

After the fall of man in the Garden of Eden, man has been in search of God, which invariably brought about religion.

However, religion could not bring perfect work of salvation because salvation cannot be done by man's search for God.

But when the proper time had fully come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born subject to [the regulations of] the Law, To purchase the freedom of (to ransom, to redeem, to atone for) those who were subject to the Law, that we might be adopted and have sonship conferred upon us [and be recognized as God's sons].
